This workshop is an accelerated learning experience designed to teach participants how to practically apply Lean concepts to improve supply chain performance. The workshop uses a physical board-based simulation as the primary learning instrument, supported by the integration of lecture and discussion.

Participants are introduced to Flow Kaizen methodology, an improvement approach that focuses on optimizing extended flows by reducing total lead-time. In three rounds, participants experience a traditional Make-to-Plan System (Push), then a Replenish-to-Order System (pull), and then finally a Build-to-Demand System (Mixed Model Lean).

The learning environment gives participants the opportunity to improve their supply chain decision-making skills, strategic thinking skills, and collaborative teaming skills.

Learning Objectives:

- Immerse yourself in an exciting scenario, as suppliers, customers and/or employees of Time Wise, Inc.
- Experience the frustrations inherent in traditional supply chain environments and realize the benefits of applying principles of Lean manufacturing in order to transform the entire supply chain.
- Understand supply chain improvement as a way to profitably meet rising customer expectations in a changing market.
- Learn Lean concepts, apply a toolset for successful Lean transformation and measure supply chain improvements that benefit customers, the company and suppliers.
